



Preparing and Guide Lines for the Photoshoot

At Crystal Clear Studios we like to capture people's natural side and hence try to avoid telling them to wear one or two specific colours. However, there are some rules that still apply and that would be to still have your outfits/accessories match each other and also the background in the case of location.

Clothing Options:

1. Examples to match your colours if there are more than 1 person in the shoot.

- a. Busy prints can work if there are 2 people in the photo shoot. Only one person can wear a print and the other one would need to wear a colour that match a colour within the print.



These are just examples of how to choose colours for the other person in the case that one person decides to wear a printed shirt/dress.

- b. For bigger groups it is best to wear blue jeans/black trousers/skirts with everyone wearing the same/similar colour shirt/blouse.

E.g. blue jeans with black/white shirts

Or

Black trousers with blue shirts/blouses

- c. Sometimes it is nice to have a change of outfit. If your shoot only allows one outfit then you can bring along other accessories/jackets/handbags for a slight change.
- d. Try wearing outfits that match your personality.
- e. Remember, bright colours on babies between 0-9 months don't look good.
- f. Lastly, you **don't want to look like a part of your background** so if you are doing your shoot in a park avoid wearing green or if you are doing your shoot on the beach, avoid wearing blue and so on.

3. Ladies:

- a. Please ensure that your nails are the way you would like them to look on the photos as we do not change nail colours or length on your photographs.
- b. If you are going to be wearing make-up, please don't wear base with sun screen as you will have reflections on your skin from the flash light.
- c. Make sure your underwear is neatly tucked away.
- d. Clean your shoes.
- e. Any waxing/shaving needs to be done before the shoot as we only do general airbrushing.
- f. Avoid wearing clothes that are too small as it creates unwanted bulges in awkward places.
- g. Make sure you are 100% comfortable with the outfit you choose to wear.

4. Gentlemen:

- a. Please remove any grease under your nails or on your hands.
 - b. Make sure your nails are short and clean.
 - c. Avoid wearing big logos.
 - d. If you don't want any facial hair on your photographs, please remove it before the time.
 - e. Clean your shoes
5. If you have any special accessories/meaningful items you would like to bring to the shoot, please feel free. The Photographer will bring some props but **personal items always work better.**
